# SAVING PLACES CONFERENCE

EHPS Board members, Doug Cohn and CJ Cullinan, attended the Colorado Preservation Inc. (CPI) Saving Places Conference entitled "Preservation for a Changing Colorado." The conference was held February 1-4, 2017 at the Colorado Convention Center.

We participated with architects, preservationists, Board members, Colorado History employees and tons of others interested in Colorado's history. There were full group presentations including high schoolers who were honored for their research and work with *The Preserve America*

*Youth Summit*. The separate lectures included *The History of Garages*, actual architectural considerations with wood and brick, *Advocacy Tips* from local officials, and *How to Leverage your Localness*, talking of the economics of small business and historic tourism.

What was really eye-opening was a full day dedicated to the State Historic Fund and the availability of the various programs that offer grants. Of course, the research and application completion was quite involved. Then there was another full-day sponsored by History Colorado and the City/

County of Denver entitled camp (Commission Assistance & Mentoring Program) on the definitions and challenges in working within and between Historic Boards and governmental entities. This day also brought up the consideration of replacement pieces for architectural buildings and spaces.

This year's conference had a \$295 registration fee which was reduced to \$125 for first-time participants. Volunteers before or during the conference received free admission. Those interested in attending next year's conference, please contact CPI at 303.893.4260.

It was exciting to meet such a diverse and determined group of individuals. It hurt to be reminded what Englewood has already lost, but we were also empowered to see what we can do to save and share our history.
