#### **Memorial** Celebration




#### **EHPS Election**

These funds will help move our 1905 wooden Colorado and Southern coach from Denver to Calhan, Colorado where we will restore it and eventually donate it to the town of Calhan.



This coach, it is hoped will play a major role in bringing the people in the area of Calhan to the railroad interpretive center. As a way of saying thank you, we invite EHPS to participate in Calhan Days on July 13th and 14th.

It is through the generous donation by EHPS that this 113 year old car will have a new chapter in its long existence. The car will be moved from its current location to Calhan about mid May. Please join us on July 13th and 14th for Calhan Depot Days and tour the station and cars being restored.
